## **Student Performance Expectations** for Using Persuasive Strategies

- Engages the audience by establishing a context, creating a voice, and otherwise creating reader interest.
- Develops a controlling idea that makes a clear and knowledgeable judgment based on evidence.
- Includes appropriate information and arguments to support the main idea.
- Excludes irrelevant information and arguments.
- Anticipates and addresses reader concerns, counterarguments, or other points of view.
- Supports arguments with detailed evidence, citing sources of information as appropriate.
- Provides a summary or closing to the argument, clearly stating conclusions.
