<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Engages the audience by establishing a context, creating a voice, and otherwise creating reader interest.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develops a controlling idea that makes a clear and knowledgeable judgment based on evidence.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Includes appropriate information and arguments to support the main idea.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Excludes irrelevant information and arguments.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Anticipates and addresses reader concerns, counterarguments, or other points of view.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Supports arguments with detailed evidence, citing sources of information as appropriate.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides a summary or closing to the argument, clearly stating conclusions.
