- Book review (book talk format)
- A sequel to the story
- A timeline of the story
- A new ending for the book
- Collages representing different characters
- A new cover for the book
- Diary of a character (from start to finish of the book)
- A piece of artwork (painting, sculpture, poem, mobile, collage) interpreting the book
- The story rewritten for younger kids as a picture book
- Gravestone and eulogy for a character
- A scrapbook about the story
- A song or dance about the book
- Background/research on the setting or period
- Interview with the author (fictional or real)
