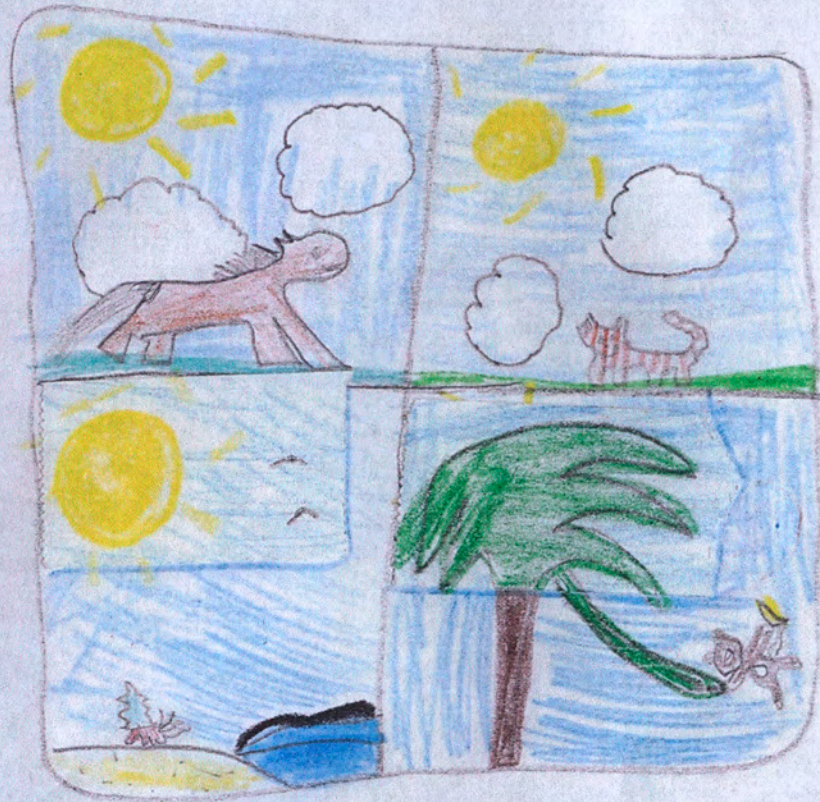


- followed Henkes model

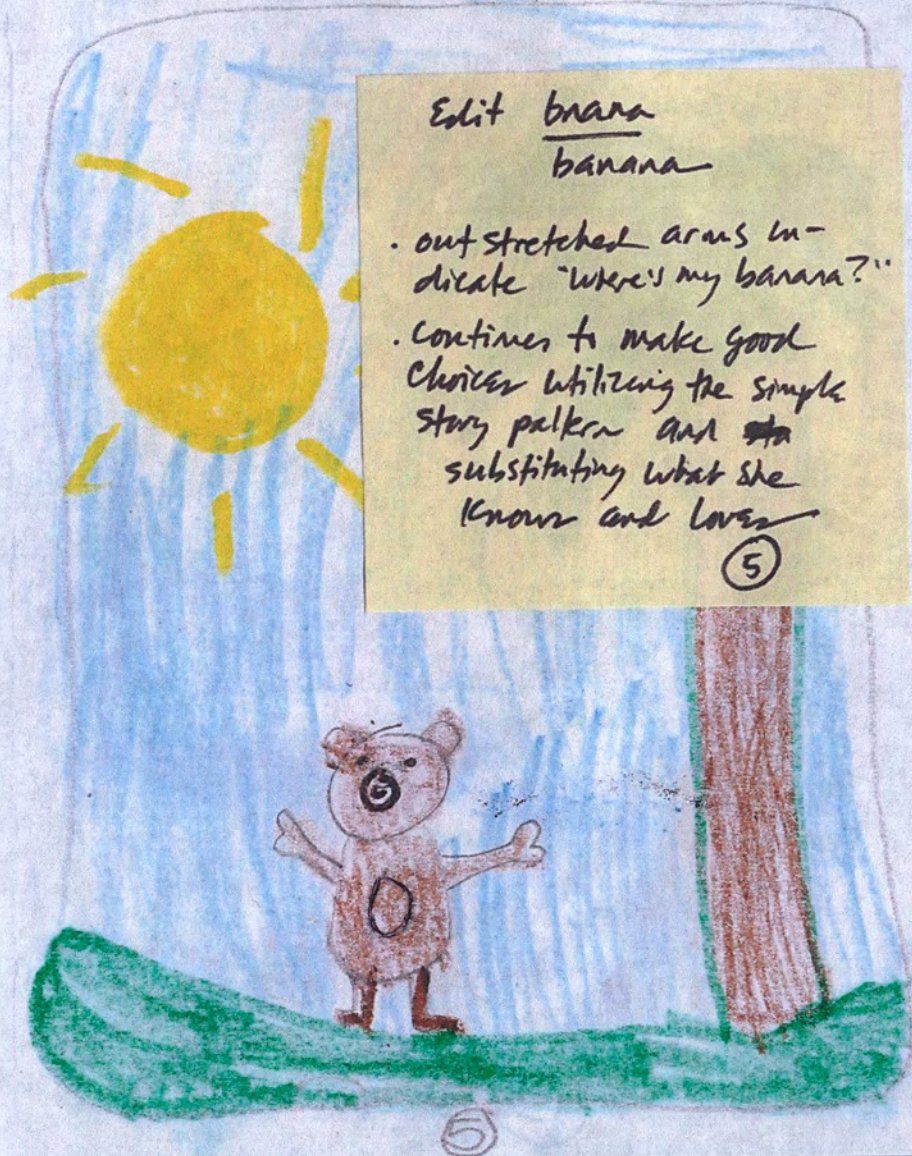

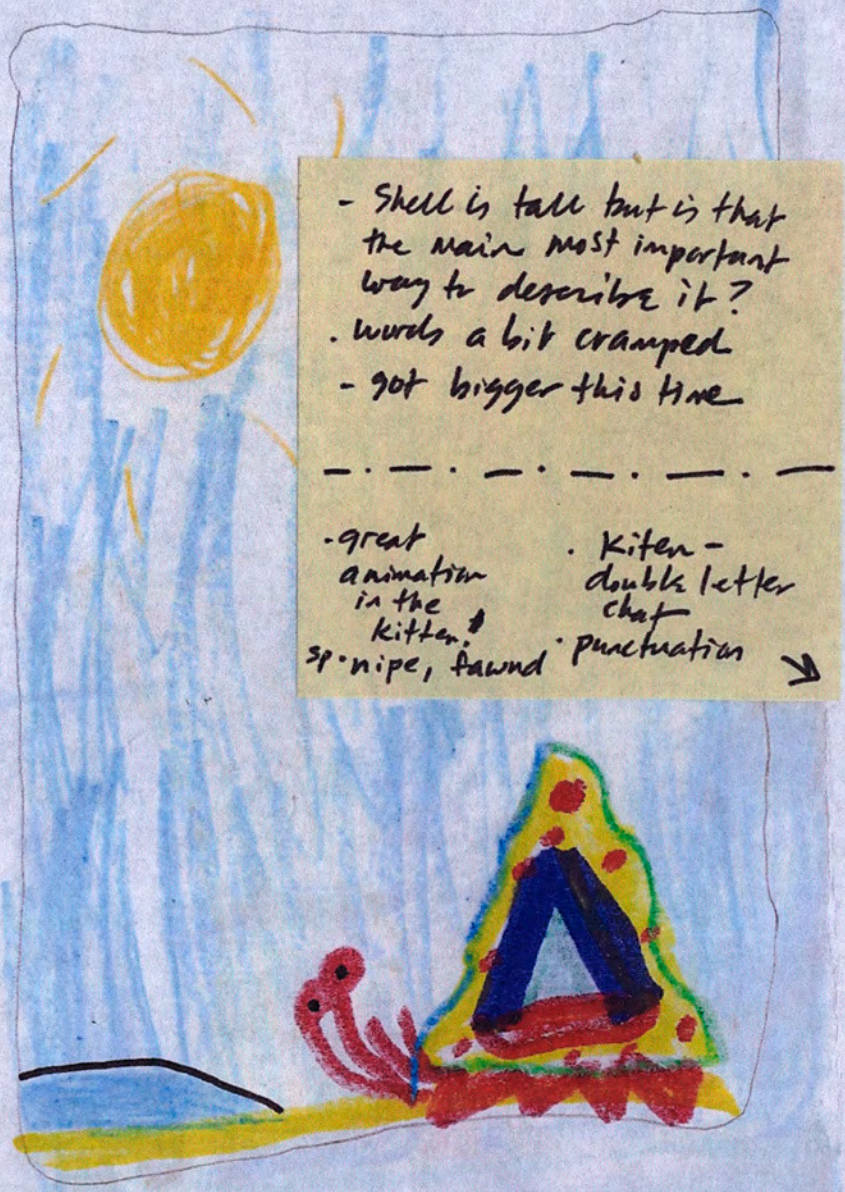
