Allocated Versus Actual Timekeeper

Administrators, coaches, teachers, students, and even student teachers, interns, or volunteers can help keep track of allocated versus actual time for literacy, or for each active ingredient of literacy (see Chapter 4). Though you may not need to see literate activity 100 percent of the time, conversations about how time is spent, and whether it is being spent as intended, can be valuable for planning and understanding the rhythm of instruction across grades and classrooms.
